Firewise communities take action to become more resistant to wildfire and create safer neighborhoods. Neighborhood Contacts help the community by sharing and collecting Firewise information between their Banner Mountain neighbors.

A Neighborhood Contact:

- 1. Identifies the neighborhood street name(s) and addresses he or she will represent.
- 2. Develops an easy way to communicate with the identified neighborhood group.
- 3. Attends BMFC meetings or reviews the meeting minutes.
- 4. Shares provided information with their neighborhood group.
- 5. Encourages communication, cooperation, and self-reliance among the neighborhood group for emergency preparation.
